

Luiss is a top private university with an educational model that combines academic rigor with practical relevance.


Its main features are:





Academic Programs: Bachelor's Degrees

Bachelor's programs taught in English (3 years, 180 ECTS)

Through lectures with world-renowned professors and hands-on training with corporate leaders and professionals, the internationally recognized Luiss Bachelor's degree constitutes a valuable tool to kick-start a challenging career in entrepreneurship, business, finance and international organizations.



Economics and Business

The aim of the three-year Bachelor's degree program in Economics and Business is to train open-minded graduates who are internationally focused. The course provides solid, general preparation in the most important economic fields and offers an excellent introduction to the fields of business and finance.

In addition, students acquire solid methodological tools to understand and analyze economic and financial phenomena, including the acquisition of basic legal concepts taught within an economic framework. The three areas of specialization in the third year are Management, Economics, and Finance, giving students the chance to prepare for master's programs.

Management and Computer Science

As part of a university-wide initiative to further teaching and research in the emerging fields of digital management and data science, the Department of Business and Management offers a Bachelor's degree in Management and Computer Science, aimed at providing students with a unique educational opportunity in data science.

Co-designed by academic and business partners, this program weaves economics and management disciplines with courses in coding, machine learning and artificial intelligence to forge a breed of digital talents. In a data-driven era, managers must have interdisciplinary skills: strategic and organizational knowledge as well as computing abilities to discover patterns in data and turn them into actionable information that creates value.

Politics, Philosophy and Economics

The three-year program in Political Science, with a major in Politics, Philosophy and Economics, provides students with a mastery of methods and content for a complete understanding of contemporary politics. To achieve this goal, the program provides interdisciplinary theoretical framework including economics, politics, philosophy, law, sociology, history and communications.


The underlying concept is to offer the foundation needed to master political and institutional phenomena, debates on fundamental questions of our time as well as the economic component of contemporary discussions. The degree program offers solid preparation for a wide variety of professions, many linked to newly developed or developing subjects in the globalizing world.

Corporate Finance

Offered by the Department of Business and Management in cooperation with the Department of Economics and Finance, the Master's program in Corporate Finance reflects objectives common to both departments and covers the areas of financial economics, financial management, business planning and valuation, mergers and acquisition (M&A), capital markets, asset pricing, risk management and derivatives, while focusing on the interactions among corporations and financial markets.

The Master's program in Corporate Finance adopts innovative teaching methods that help students to translate strong theory into useful abilities. Students are continuously exposed to case studies, simulations, company presentations and experiences as well as inspiring talks by top managers and professionals.

Economics

The Master's program in Economics enables students to develop skills, methods and knowledge of decision-making, market functions and economics. The program provides cutting-edge training in theoretical and empirical techniques to make meaningful connections, informed projections and trends in macroeconomics and international finance, as well as to understand policymaking and regulation of socio-economic data.

The Master's program in Economics also offers RoME, a specialization program for particularly promising students, in collaboration with the Einaudi Institute for Economics and Finance. Students selected for the program will participate in special courses in addition to those required for the Master's program.

Finance

The Master's program in Finance offers students the opportunity to acquire quantitative skills in asset management, asset pricing and portfolio analysis in addition to deep knowledge of the role of financial markets and intermediaries, corporate governance and financial regulation.

The program also provides cutting-edge training in price formation techniques, securities trading, management of corporate finance and extraordinary transactions as well as the ability to make meaningful connections between forecasts and trends in macroeconomics and international finance.

The Master's program provides students with advanced knowledge of topics and challenges related to ethical behavior, while describing the role of ethics in asset management, banking and investment professions.

Global Management and Politics

The Master's degree program in Global Management and Politics – offered by the Department of Business and Management in cooperation with the Department of Political Science – complements topics related to management with socio-political issues, as global managers must be aware of the intricacies of world politics.

The study plan starts with the exploration of the economic, legal and economic-business foundations of global management.

The course of studies then focuses on organizational and strategic issues and, finally, ends with the analysis of important issues related to the political implications of globalization, international relations, the dynamics of international governmental and non-governmental organizations and activities related to representing corporate, stakeholder and institutional interests.

The Master's program trains professionals to perform managerial and specialist functions within international organizations, particularly in the context of global industries and services, strategic consulting firms, as well as institutions operating at supranational and international levels.

International Relations

The Luiss master's program in International Relations prepares graduates for careers in diplomacy, as international security experts for both the public and private sectors and in the management of Euro-Mediterranean issues. The program furthermore responds to the growing need for highly trained figures within international organizations and the traditional diplomatic sector that are able to handle both old and new, emerging challenges. The program branches out into three majors: Security, Mediterranean Governance and Diplomacy.

The major in Security provides tools to analyze security related issues and its main challenges. The students will be trained to deepen their knowledge on the geopolitical and strategic dynamics at global level, not only European ones.

The major in Diplomacy's main goal is to form diplomatic personnel to join international representation around the world.

The major in Mediterranean Governance is focused on politics, sociology of the Mediterranean countries, culture and political systems and different kind of migration policies.

Marketing

The Master's program in Marketing provides an integrated approach that combines advanced knowledge of consumer insights, research methods and analytical techniques with business understanding in a digitalized and interconnected world. The program offers two majors, **Marketing Analytics & Metrics** and **Market Relationships & Customer Engagement.**

The major in Marketing Analytics & Metrics focuses on the analysis and measurement of market processes, while the major in Market Relationships & Customer Engagement focuses on approaches and methods to manage engagement and relationship development with customers and business partners.

Policies and Governance in Europe

The Master's degree in Policies and Governance in Europe (PAGE) responds to a changing world in which policy decisions are taken at different linked levels. It prepares students to use public policy analysis in the outside world by drawing on different disciplines. The track focuses on how and why policy makers create, use and manage cultural heritage, that includes historic buildings, museums, cities, food and intangible heritage.

The Master's degree in Policies and Governance in Europe covers major policies made at EU, international, national, regional and local levels. It is multidisciplinary and includes the study of political science, law and economics, sociology and management. It offers a combination of analytical skills, knowledge of key domains and specific competencies. It is designed for public and private sector organisations (e.g. government agencies, EU and international institutions, museums, associations, local and regional development offices).

Students will gain practical experience through internships and gain entrance to employment opportunities in the public and private sector.

Services for International Students

Welcome Desk

Staff dedicated to providing information on administrative formalities, opportunities and initiatives, from their arrival and throughout their time at Luiss.

Housing service

Luiss works with a real estate agency to provide comfortable housing options near the university.

Italian courses

Complementary Italian courses are offered to international students to provide them with basic knowledge of the language to facilitate everyday communication.

Luiss Campuses in the Heart of Rome



Viale Pola

The historic Luiss campus and the University's headquarters. The campus is home to the Luiss Schools of Journalism and Law and hosts some courses of the Department of Law.



Viale Romania

Completely renovated in 2007, the campus is home to the Departments of Economics and Finance, Business and Management, and Political Science. The grounds of over 33,000m2 are set in a park in the center of Rome with advanced technology and services.

Luiss is located in Rome, a World Heritage City, where art, history and culture provide an inspiring environment.

The University is situated in one of Rome's most attractive neighborhoods, with buildings that mirror the atmosphere and the beauty of the city.



Via Parenzo

Housing the Department of Law, this building from the 1930s is considered one of the best examples of the period's architectural trends, structured into various spaces and terraces. Studying here means living in a community.



Villa Blanc

An architectural jewel of the 19th century, Villa Blanc is home to the Luiss Business School, ensuring students a unique learning experience thanks to a combination of digital technologies and a prestigious historical setting.

Luiss Residences

Luiss helps students find conveniently located housing based on their personal needs through three types of services: university residences, small apartments with double rooms and common areas, contracted residences, facilities that offer rooms and services at a discounted price for Luiss students and private rooms and apartments, for which students can use the free brokerage service CasaLuiss.



Via di Santa Costanza

Located in the Luiss Library building, close to the Viale Pola and Via Parenzo campuses. The structure has single and double rooms with in-room bathrooms and cleaning services including linens. The building has a doorman, complete kitchens on every floor, a common area, laundry room and Wi-Fi connection.



Viale Pola

Located by the historic Luiss campus, (home to the Department of Law and the School of Law), close to the Via Parenzo campus (Department of Law) and connected to the Viale Romania campus by the University's free shuttle bus service. The residence offers 18 spaces in single and double rooms, doorman, shared kitchen, a common area, laundry room and Wi-Fi connection.



Via Lisbona

Located next to the Viale Romania campus, the structure has single and double rooms, double suites with in-room bathrooms and cleaning services including linens. The building has a doorman, night security, a common room, laundry room and a Wi-Fi connection.



Via Antelao

This facility is divided into small apartments with a living room, kitchenette, bathroom and double bedrooms. Available services include a doorman and night security, laundry room, occasional cleaning, common areas, reading room, central heating, outdoor space, technical assistance, a Wi-Fi connection and electric bike rental.

Luiss Library

The library's acquisitions support the University's teaching and research programs. Its collection in continuous growth.

In 2019, the library's collection amounted to 103,110 books, 1,171 paper journals and 180 databases.

The library also provides access to 97,383 e-journals and 110,688 e-books.

After a complete remodel, the library consists of three different study rooms and offers support in bibliographical research and in the use of digital resources. While the facility is open from Monday to Saturday, the catalogues can be comfortably accessed remotely, so students can access information at any time.

Adoption Lab

The Adoption Lab Project connects students with companies, helping them to deepen the knowledge of the world of work.

The employers of leading companies adopt the students selected by the project, offering them the chance to work on some projects and the opportunity to do an internship after graduation.

During the first year of the program, AdLab arranges visits to headquarters of partner companies and meetings with employers, who explain company policies and skills required to reach important professional goals.

The second year focuses on putting acquired skills to work and testing participants' problem-solving and teamwork skills. In addition, host companies give to AdLab students specific projects to work on as consultants. Luiss tutors collaborate with teams and companies, supervising the activities. At the end of the second year's first semester, the adopted students present their projects in the presence of employers, who give their opinions about the collaboration period as well as advice regarding résumé preparation.

Top students may be offered an internship at a partner company after graduation.

Financial Aid

Luiss University awards merit-based scholarships to talented students based on the overall assessment of applications. Scholarships are offered by the admission board upon the admission to the most outstanding candidates.
